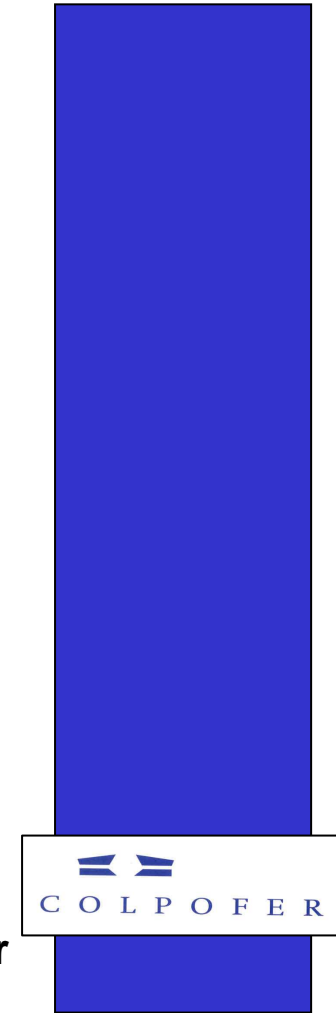
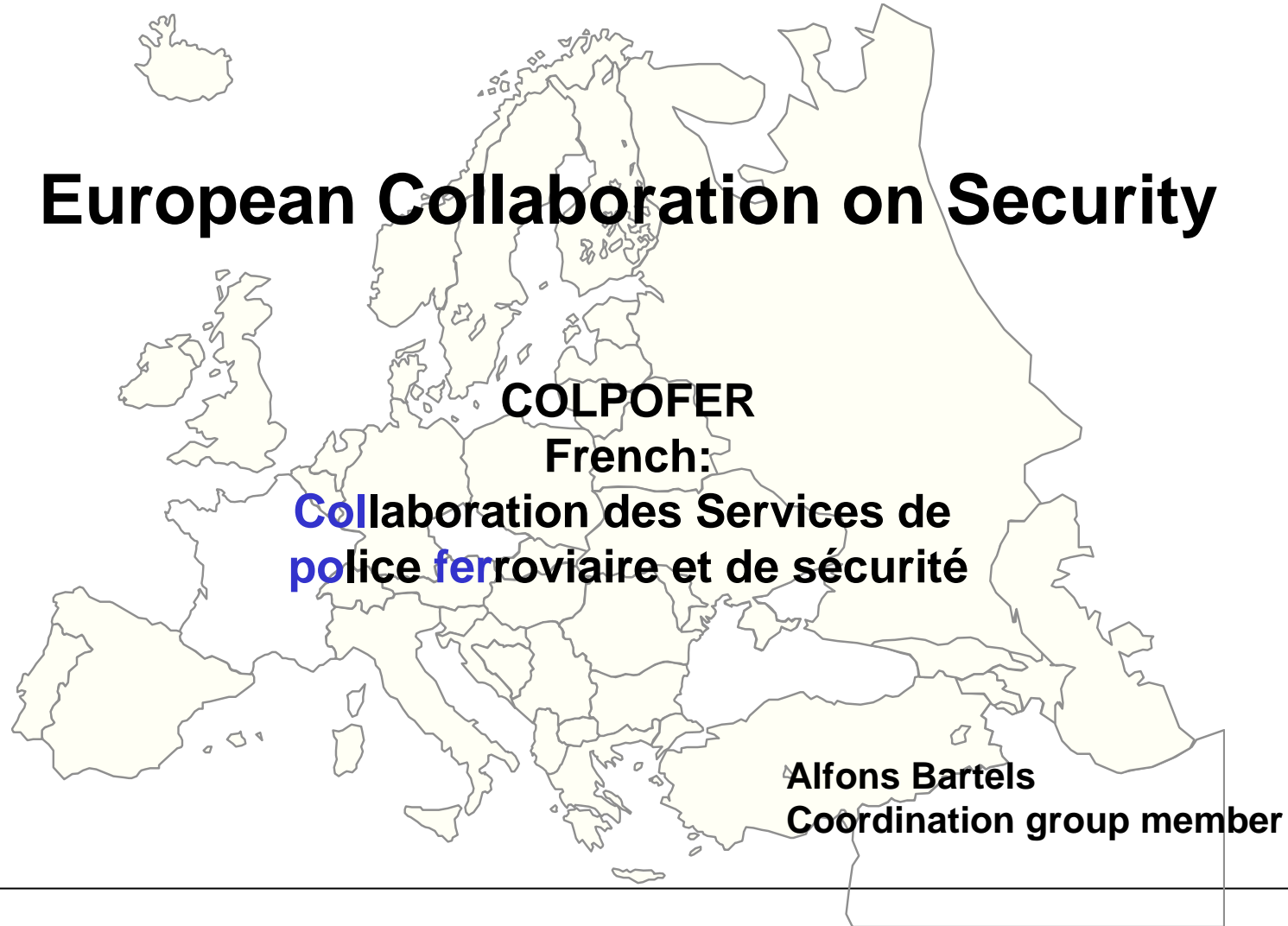


European Collaboration on Security

COLPOFER is a European collaborative association, founded in **1981** by NS and Netherlands railway police.

Since 1998 COLPOFER has been a special group within the UIC, and since 2008 as the European section of the worldwide UIC security platform.

Assigned members are railway companies, railway police forces, railway security services and other organisations which deal with railway security.

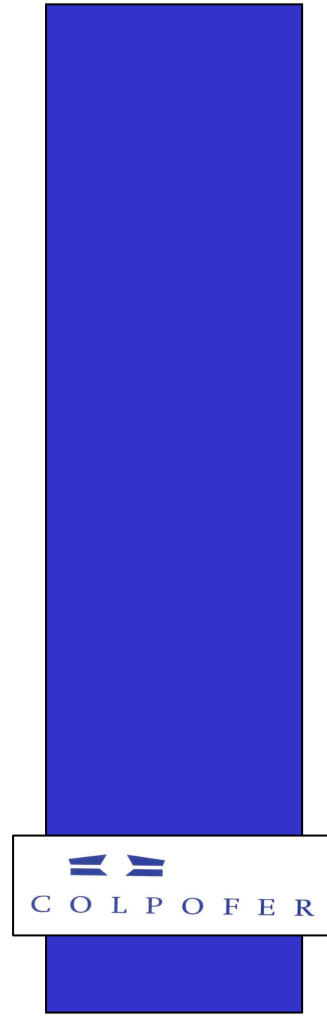
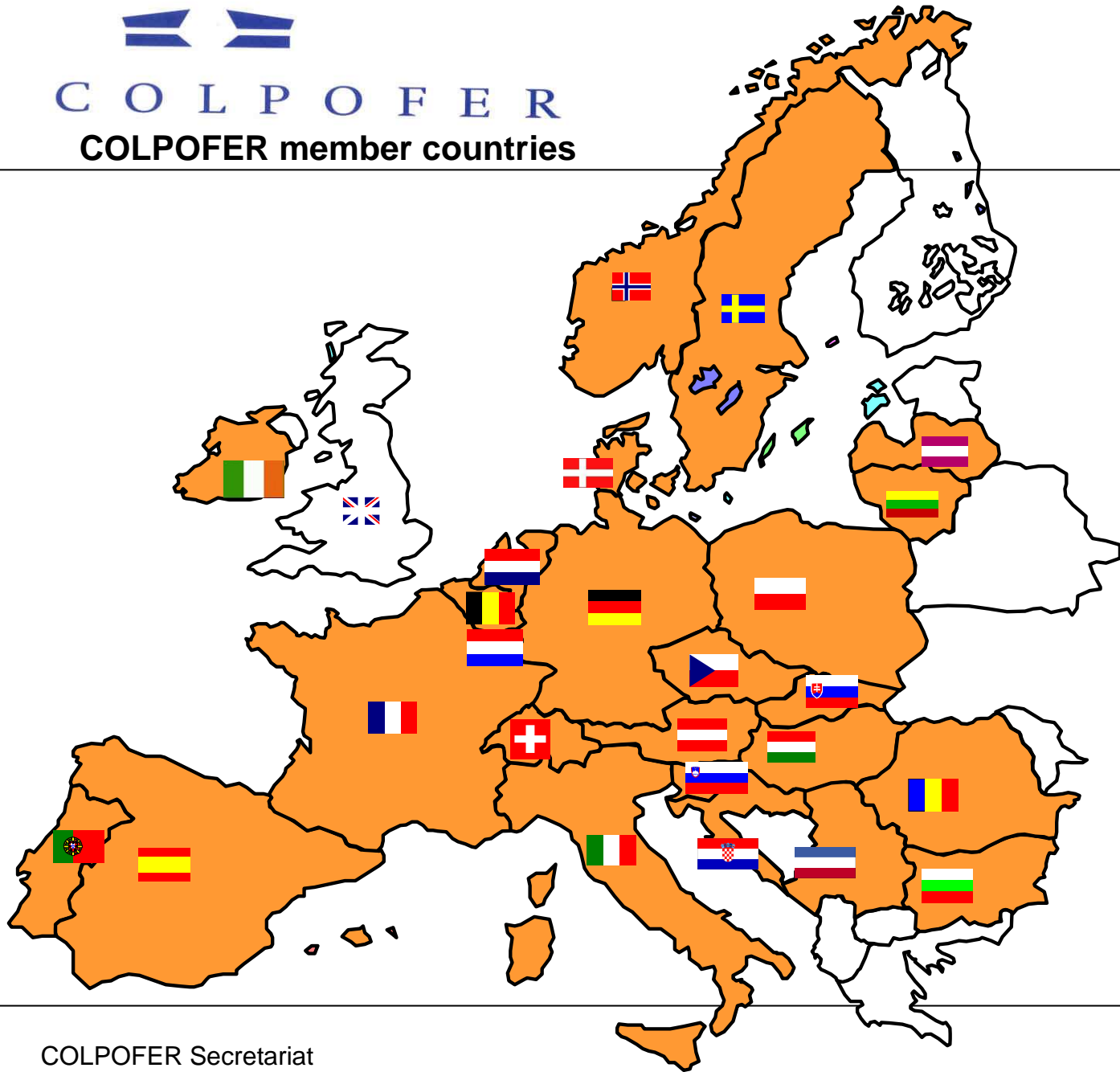
Today there are 42 railway and police organisations from 25 European countries enrolled in COLPOFER.

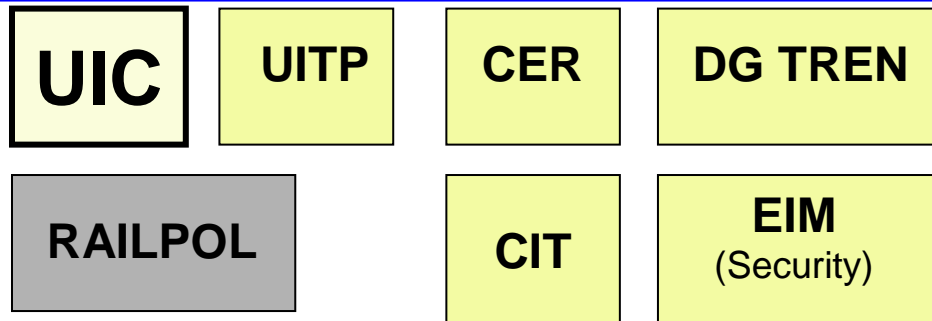
Security Platform

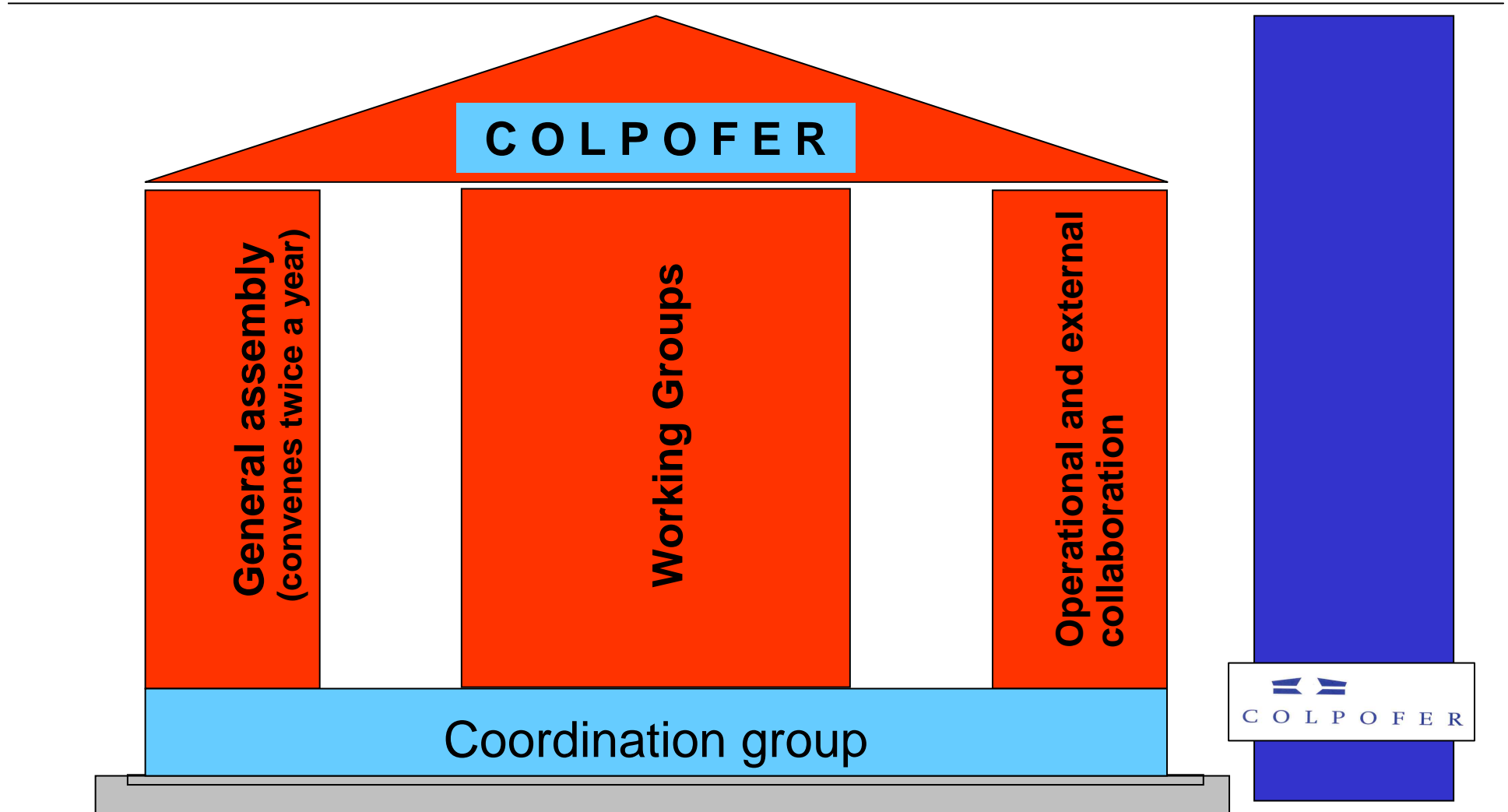


Security as the common goal of hazard control by the police and the security precautions taken by companies
