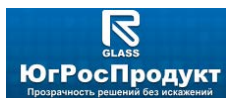

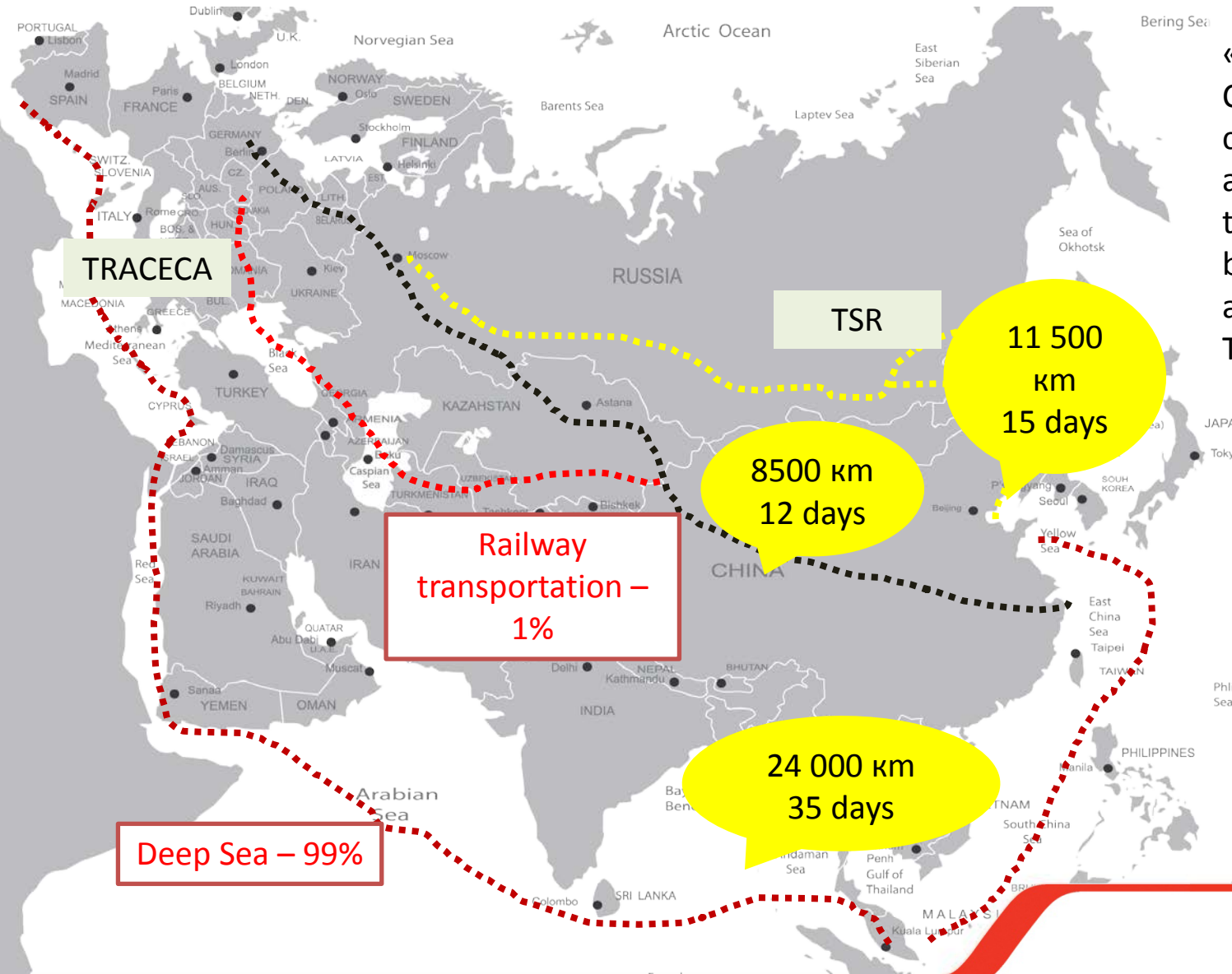




Two main routes are connecting the Central European countries with the consolidation and border crossing point – Dobra Terminal.
